Dear High school seniors:

To those of you who plan to enroll in institutions of higher learning during the next academic year, you are encouraged to apply for the Consolidated District Scholarship Award. The following eligibility/criteria are as follows:

- 1. Applicants must be active members of a registered church in the Consolidated District and an active member of the Youth department of the Consolidated District Sunday School and BTU Convention.**
- 2. Applicants must be high school graduates in the academic year of eligibility.**
- 3. Applicants must submit all required documentations:**
 - **The attached application**
 - **The typed essay**
 - **An OFFICIAL, Sealed transcript, which should include ACT/SAT scores**
 - **Three letters of recommendation—one from your pastor and two others--signed**
- 4. Applicants must submit an official transcript and current transcript of grades. Grades for the first semester of the senior year must be on the transcript if grades for the second semester are not available. Applicants must have an “unweighted” 2.75 G.P.A. or higher to apply.**
- 5. The typed essay topic for this year is “How to Live a Christian Life in today’s world” Scriptural examples are Romans 12:1-2 and John 15: 18-19. The essay needs to be 500 words or more in length, double-spaced in size 12 fonts. The essay should include personal accounts from the applicant, along with a Christian perspective on this topic and should demonstrate clarity, coherence, proper usage, mechanics, adherence to the theme, and enough details to develop the concept.**
- 6. Three typed letters of recommendation must also be included from the following: a) Your pastor (if the church is without a pastor, the interim pastor or District Youth minister may submit a letter); b) Teacher or counselor; and c) Community leader/Employer. These letters should speak about your leadership, academic preparedness, and commitment as a youth. Make sure all letters are SIGNED!**
- 7. Scholarships will be given in the following amounts: First place: \$500.00, Second Place: \$300.00, and Third Place: \$200.00.**
- 8. Application packets/materials are to be secured in a folder and mailed in an envelope to the scholarship chairperson at the following address: Alyce S. Emerson, 2029 Bamboo Drive, Lexington, KY 40513. The deadline for ALL packets is ***midnight, May 1, 2019**

CONSOLIDATED DISTRICT CONTINUING EDUCATION AWARD

- **Who is eligible for this award?**

- Any member of a registered Consolidated District Church
- Any young adult/older adult member who has a desire to continue his/her educational goals
- Examples: College degrees, Graduate school, Law school, Seminary, Technical/Business schools
- Anyone who has a desire to achieve and improve their academic goals
- This is a ONE time only application—cannot continue to reapply

- **What is required?**

- Applicants must be a high school graduate or have an equivalency/GED
- Applicants must have a 2.5 GPA **unweighted** (from most recent transcript)

What is the process?

- Applicants must type a 1-2 page Letter of Application, explaining their goals, career plans, etc.
- Applicants must complete the Application form (attached to packet)
- Applicants must submit **3** letters of recommendation (**one must come from your pastor**, other examples: employer, colleagues, professors, etc.)
- Applicants must include most recent and **official transcript** (high school and/or college depending on age of applicant) with the packet
- All information needs to be complete and secured in a folder/ mailing envelope

What are the deadlines for the scholarship?

- The deadline for all Consolidated District Scholarships is midnight, *****May 1, 2019**
- Applicants are to mail completed applications to Sister Alyce S. Emerson @ 2029 Bamboo Drive, Lexington, Ky. 40513, by this deadline
- Recipients will be notified prior to the Consolidated District Convention in July
